WEST PIEDMONT MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE ADOPTION

The West Piedmont Planning District Commission has been working to update the regional Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, originally adopted in 2006 and last updated in 2016. The purpose of the plan is to identify potential natural and man-made hazards, understand our risks and vulnerabilities, and develop strategies to address them. The plan is scheduled for official adoption on June 15, 2022, by the Town of Stuart, Virginia at a regularly scheduled meeting.
